 - Industry



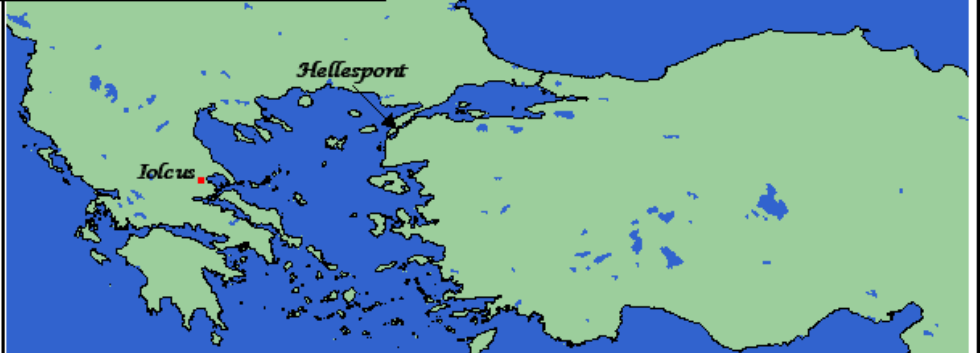

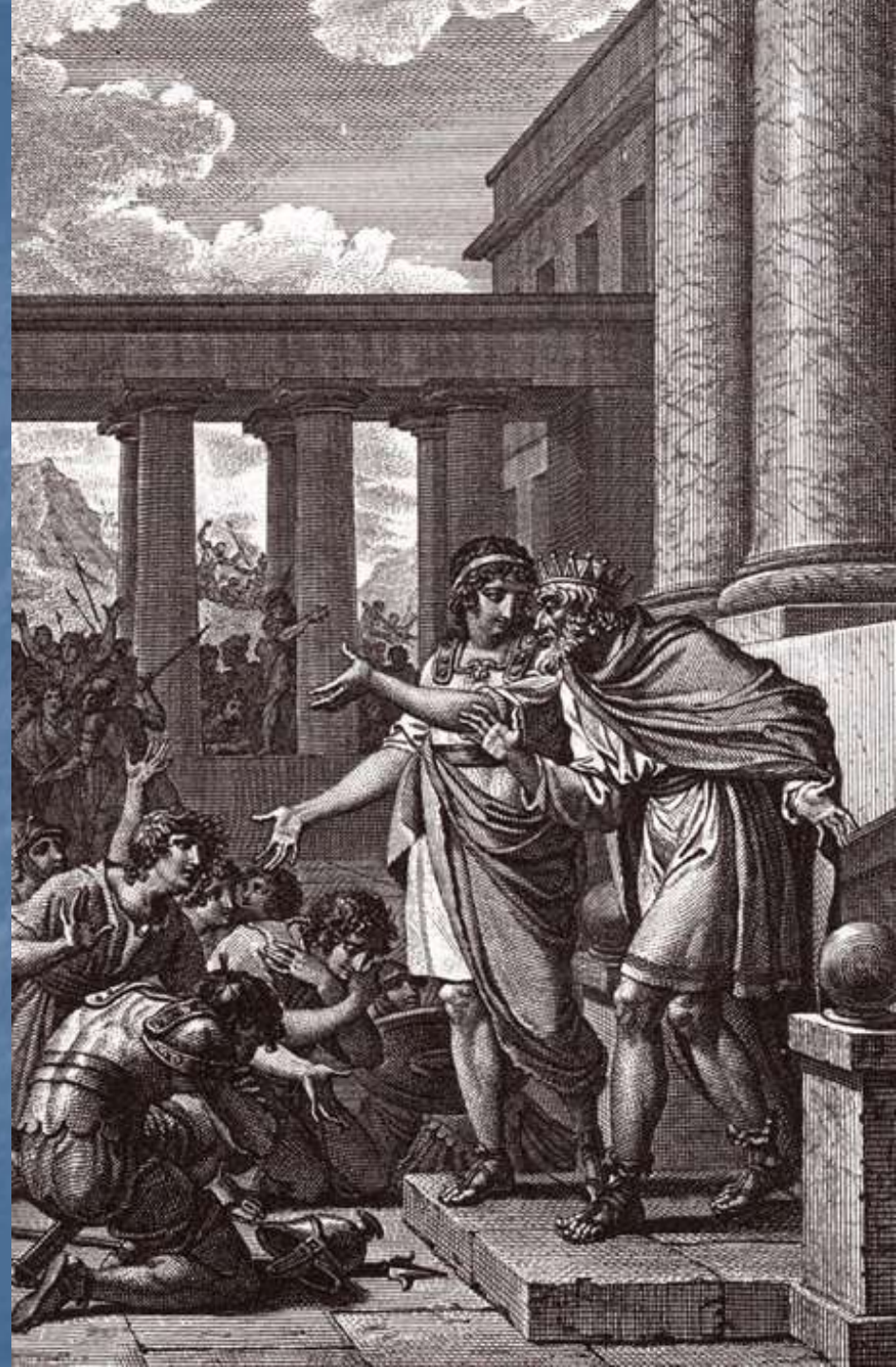




The Tyrants
