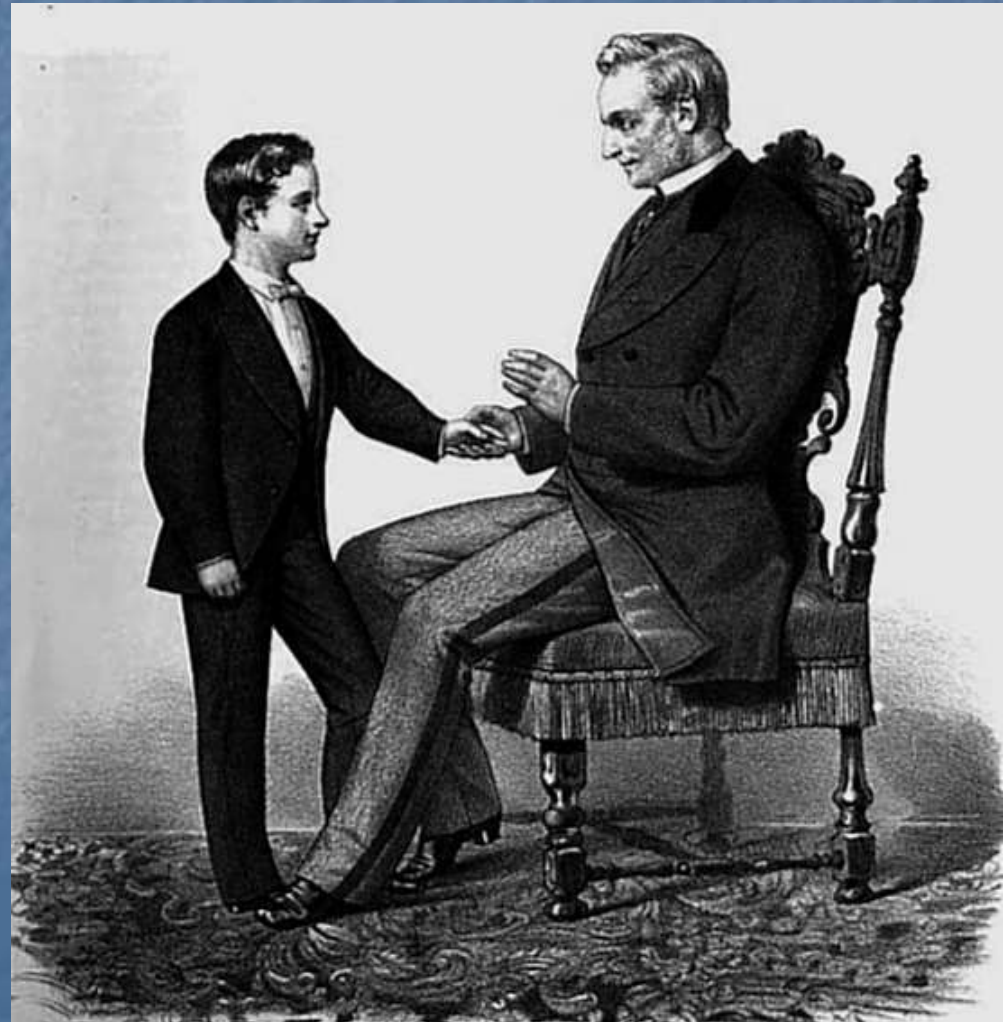
■ 19th-century Roles
