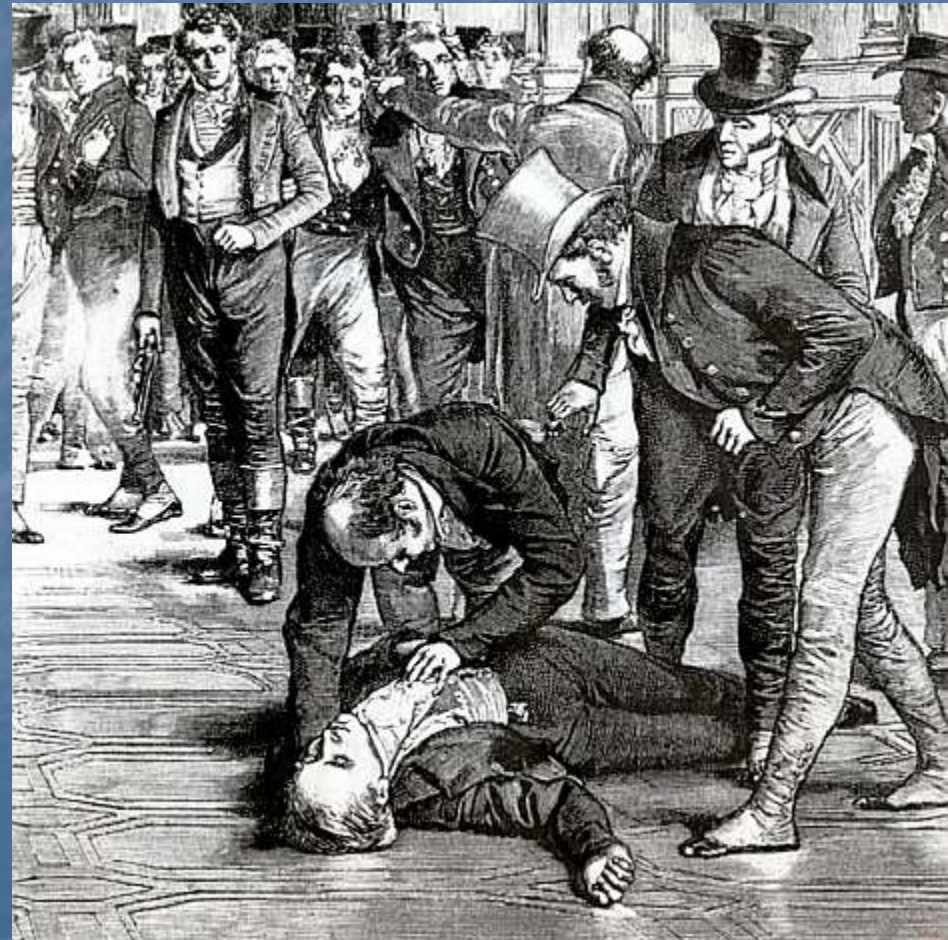

 - Professionally trained

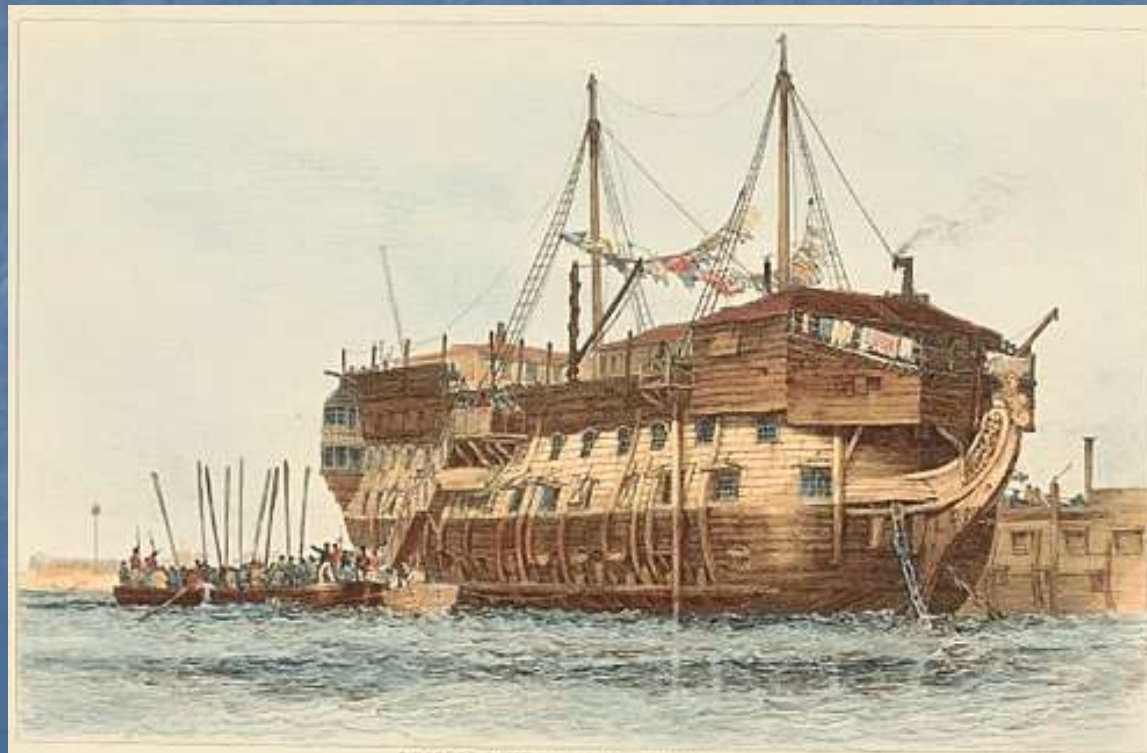


- Paris Police Force
