

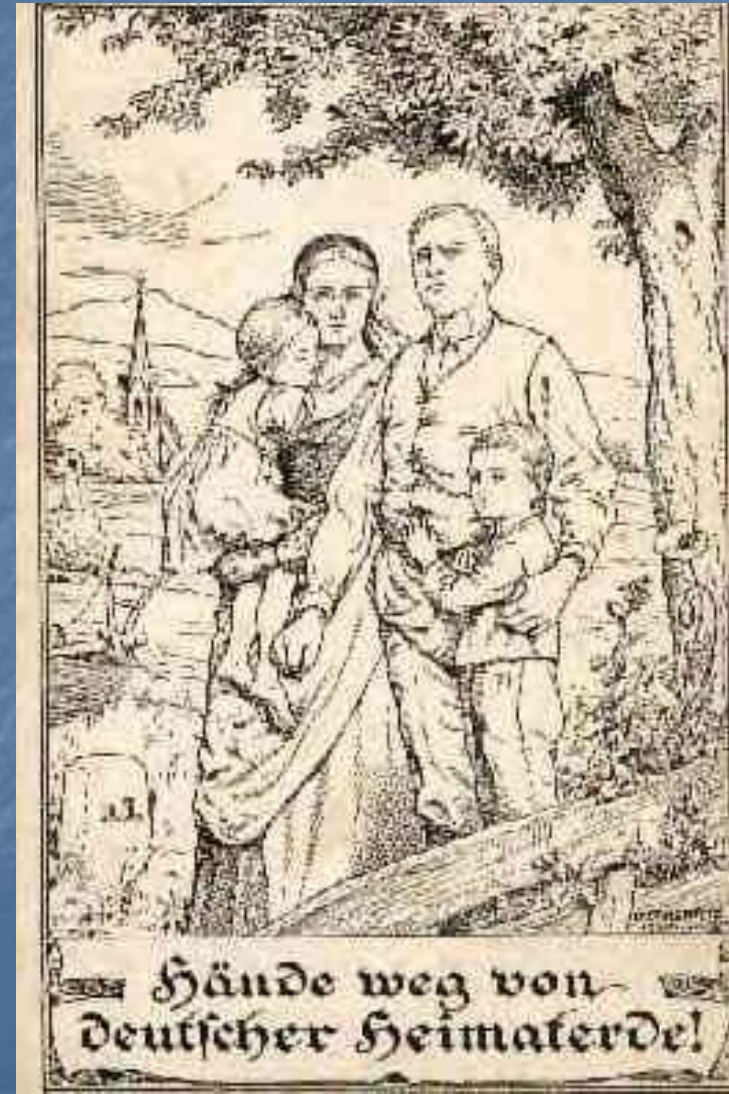

 - Self-determination



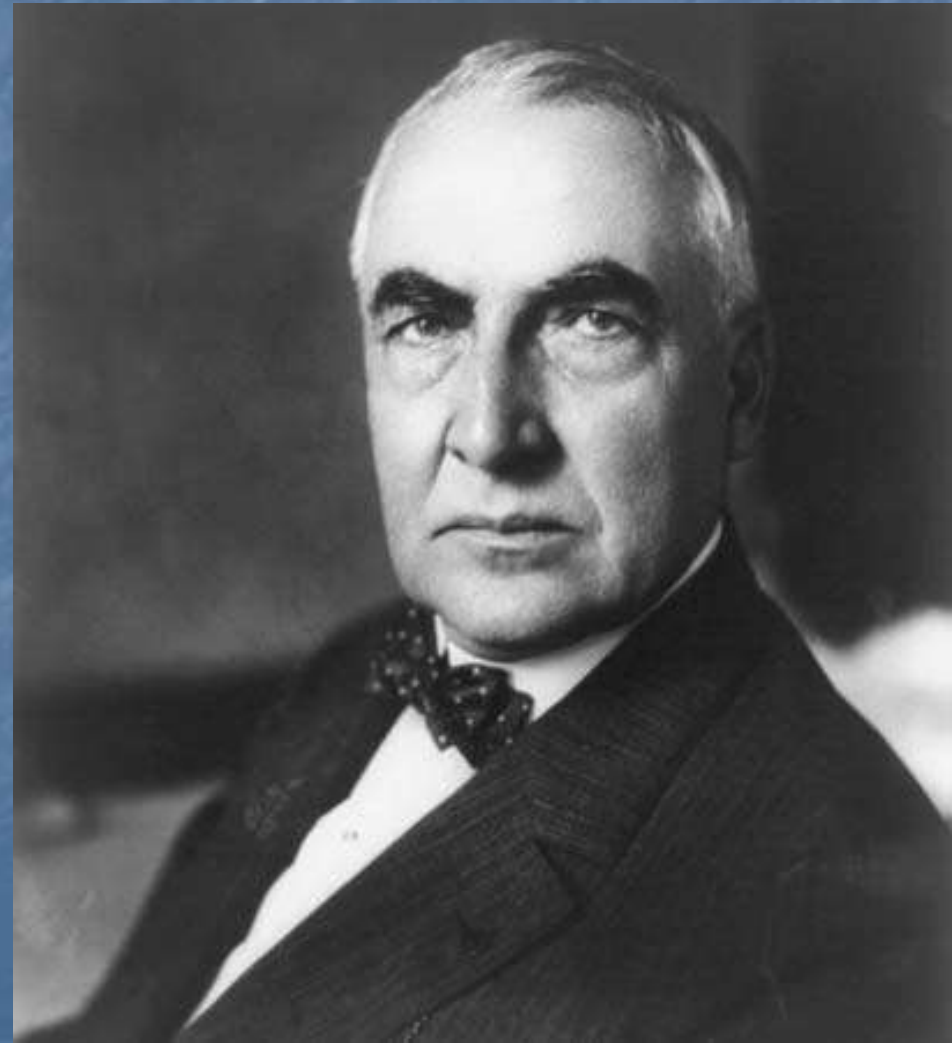
■ Demands For Revision cont.
