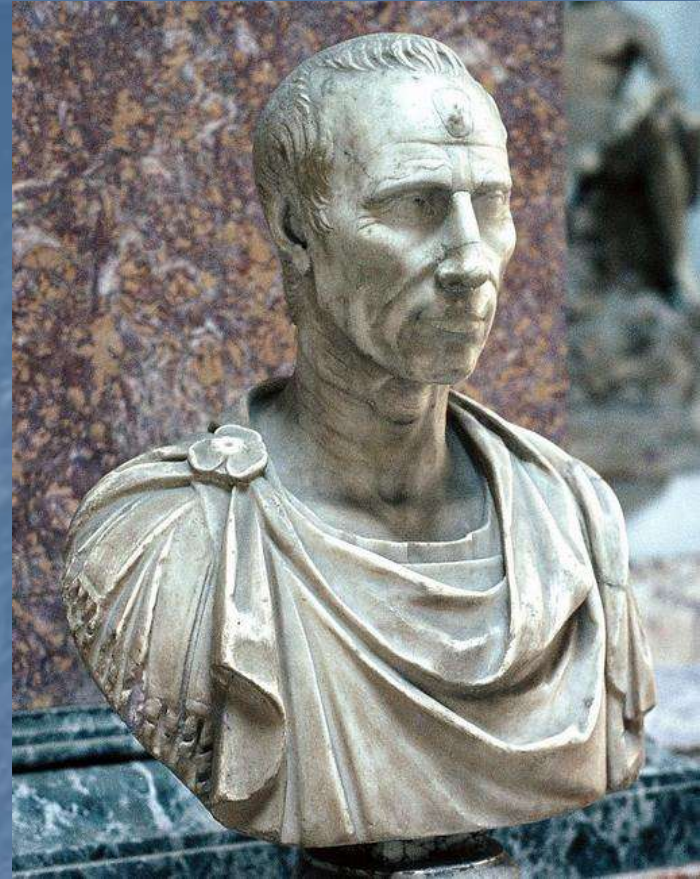

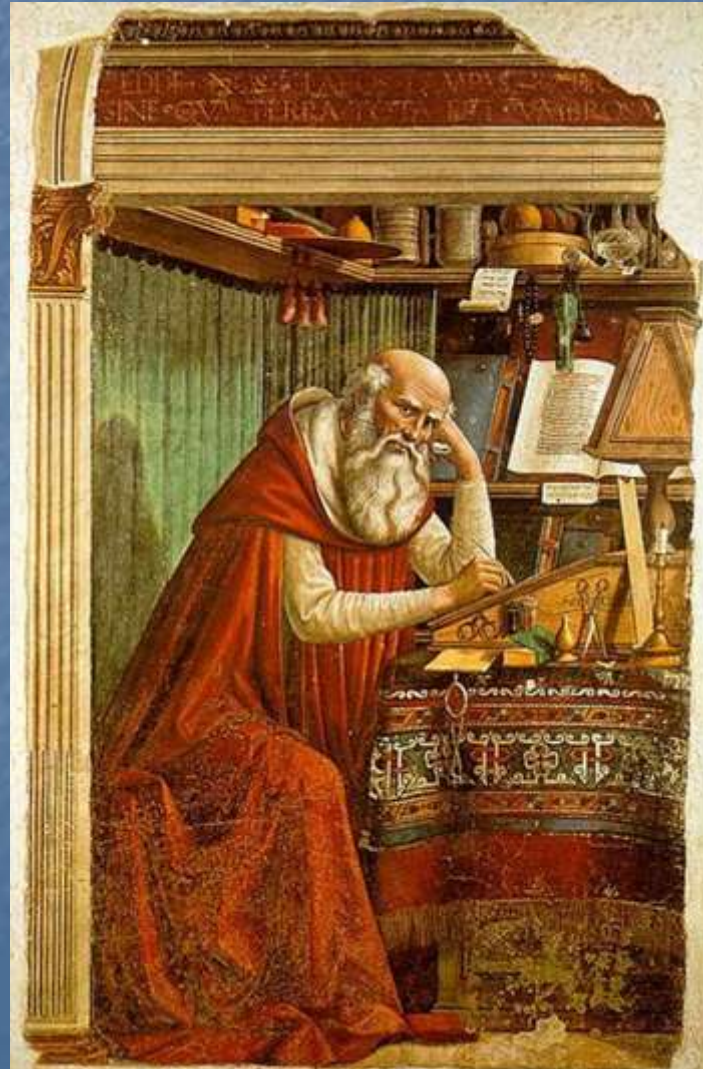


- Livy

- Jerome

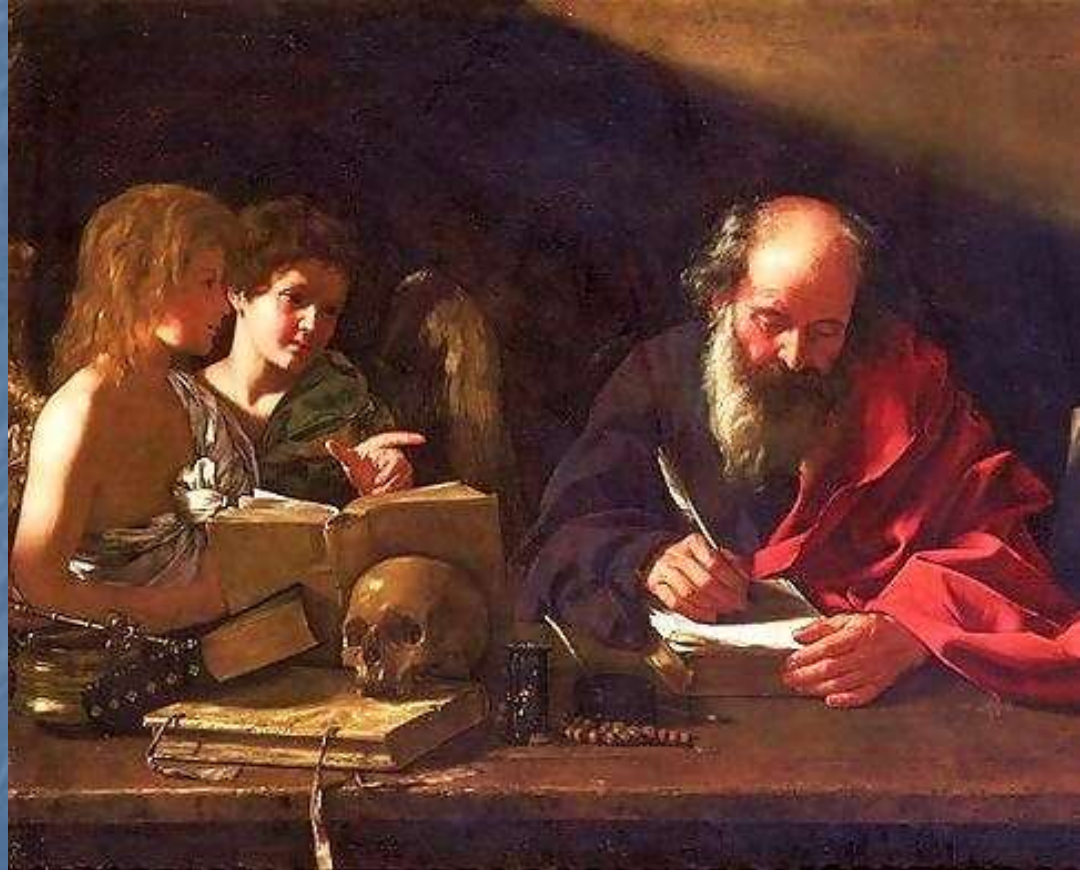
- 405 A.D.

- *Vulgate*

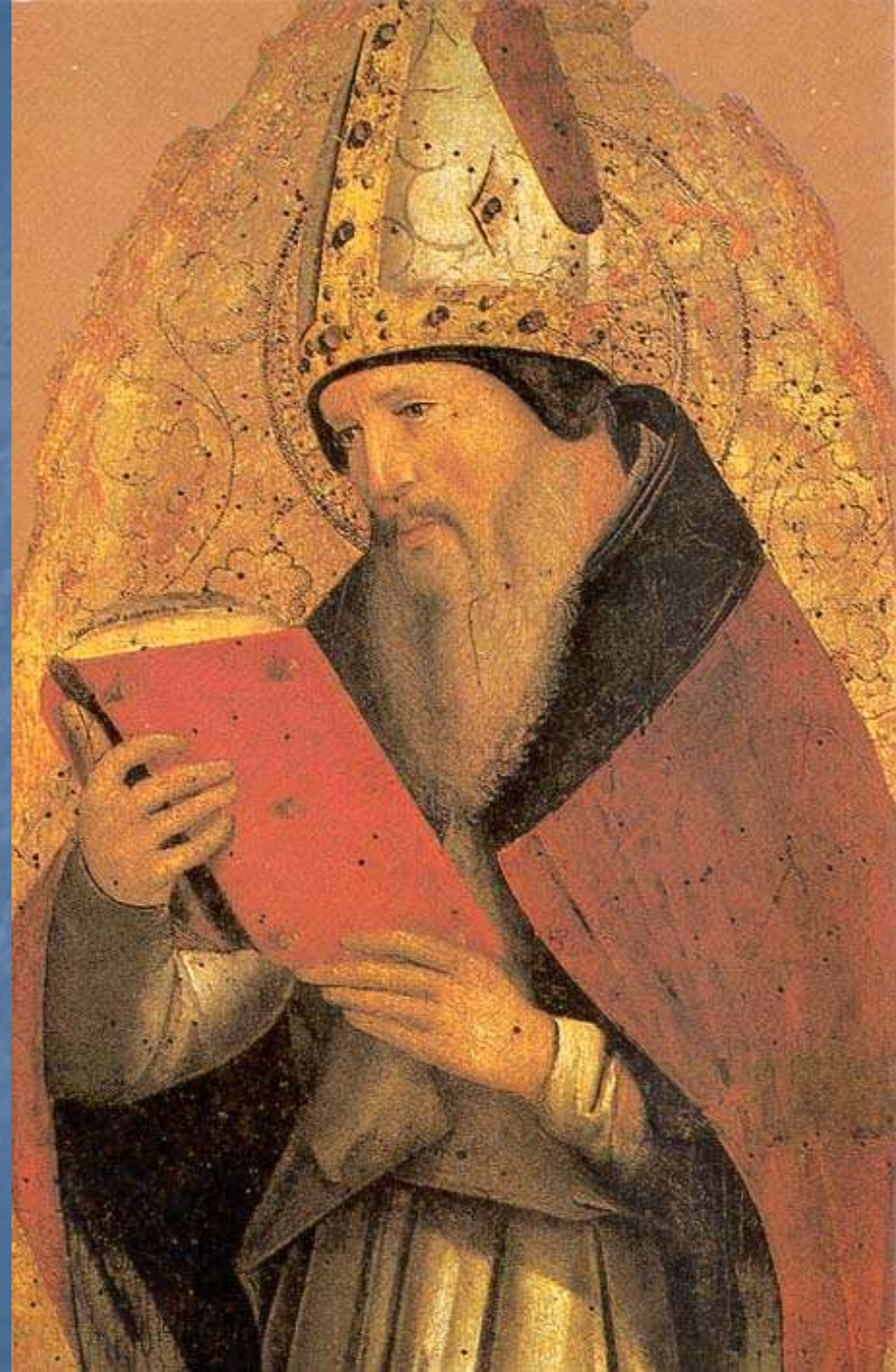
- Still used by the Catholic Church



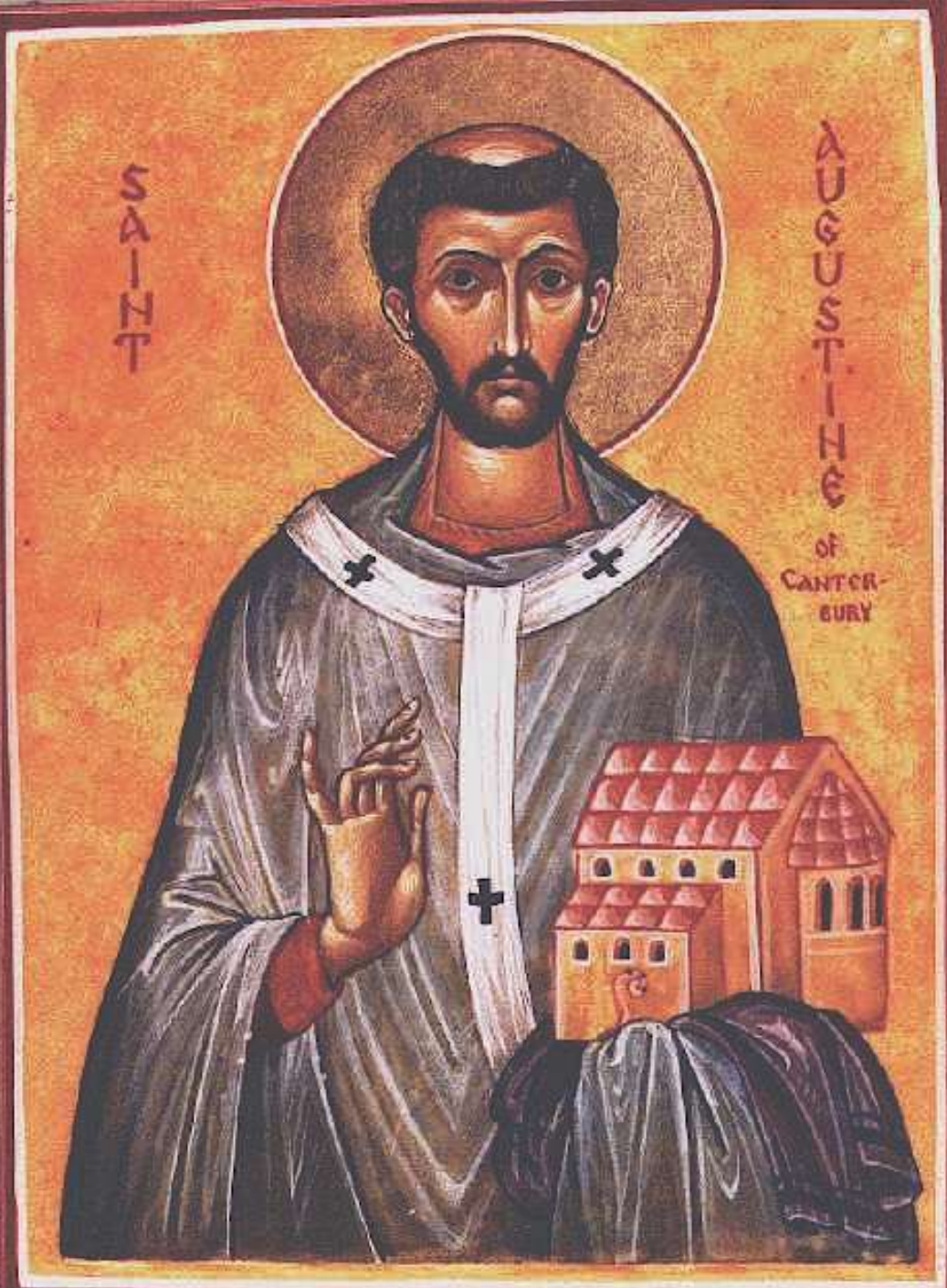
- Eusebius
