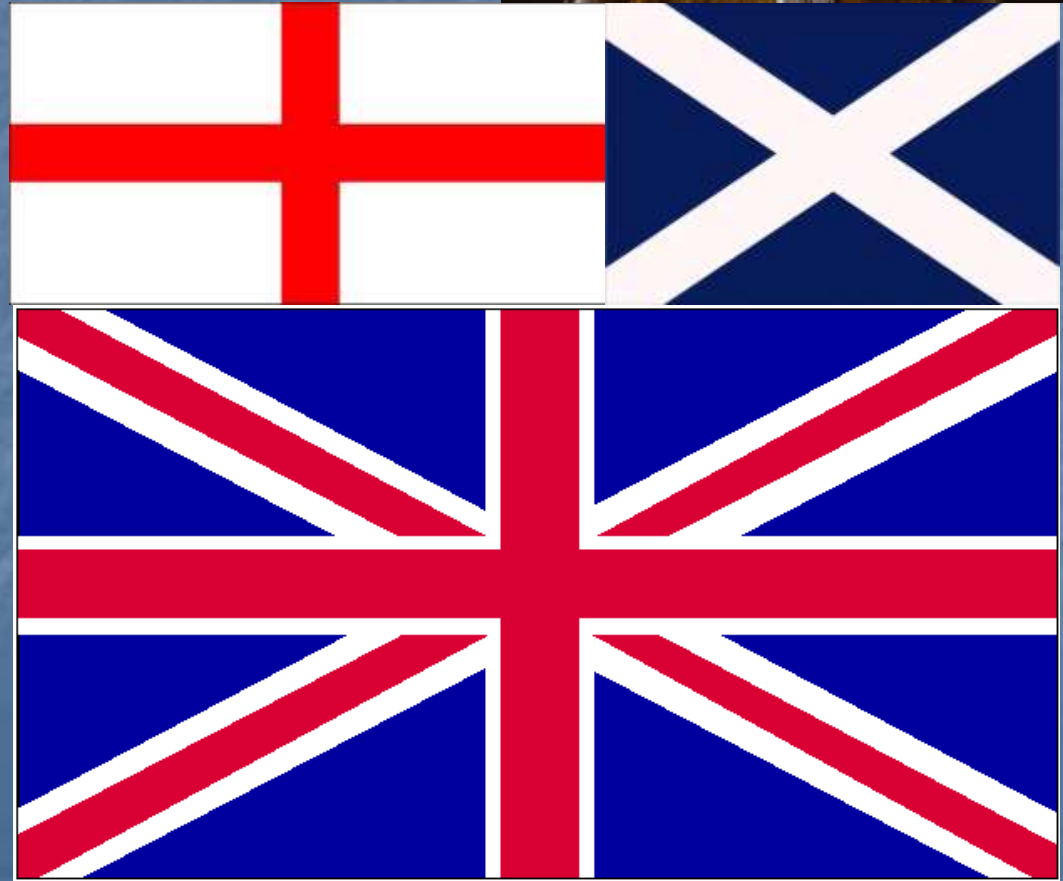

- The most senior cabinet minister in the executive branch of government in a parliamentary system



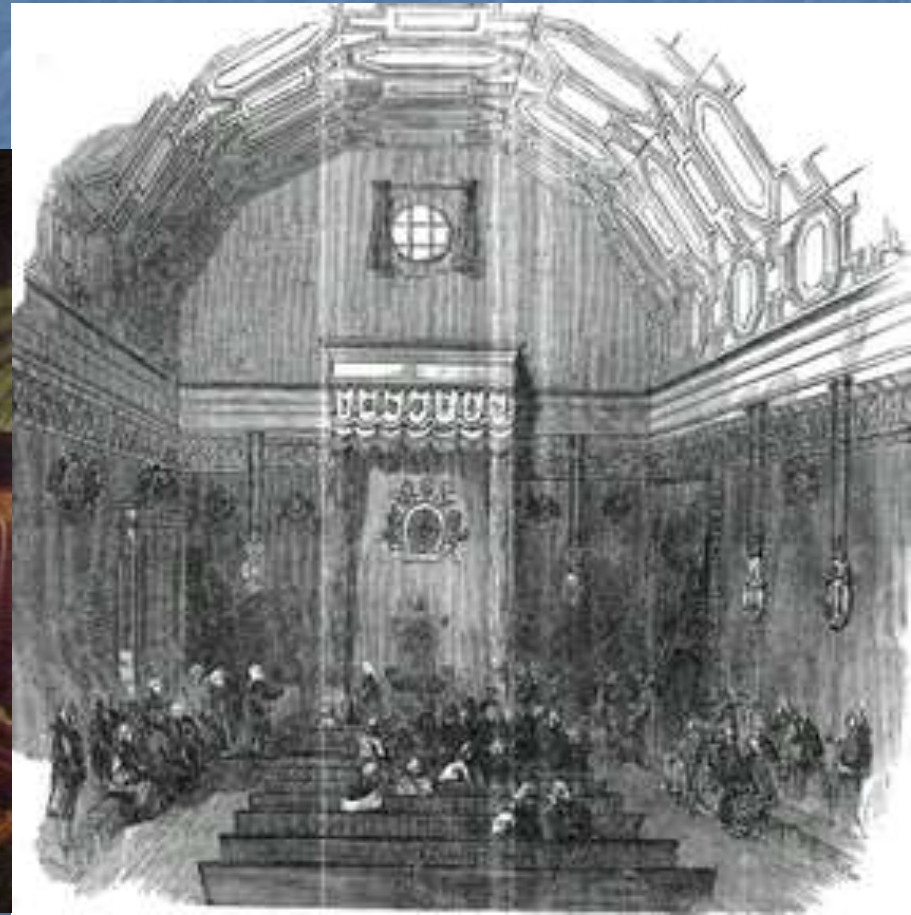

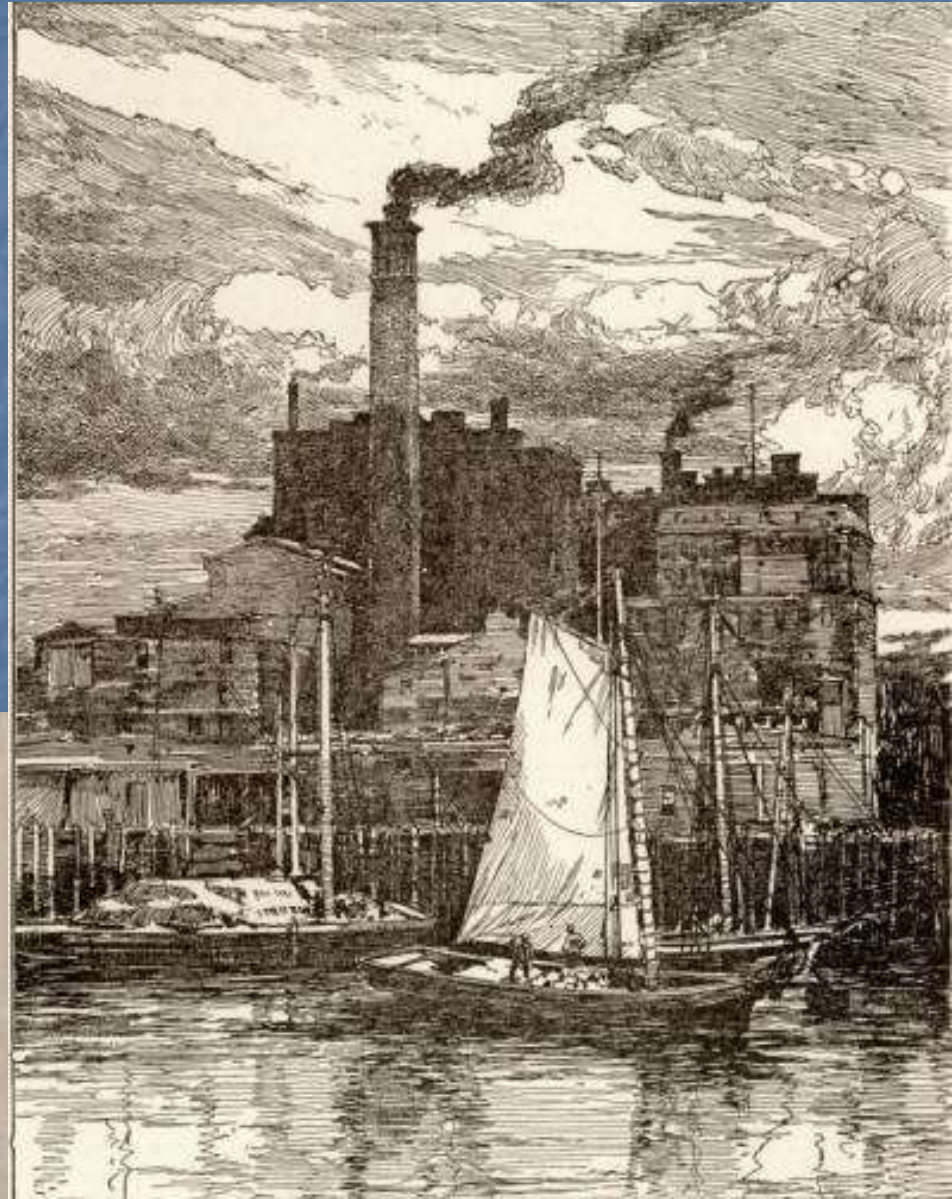

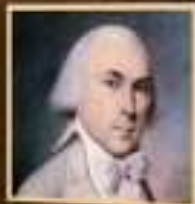
